<h3>NOMINATION</h3>	<p>Must be sent at: exchange@agh.edu.pl by the Partner University (not a student)</p> <p>Nomination deadlines:</p> <p>31.05.2025 – nominations for the Winter semester (October - February) or for the whole academic year (October - June)</p> <p>15.11.2025 – nominations for the Summer semester (February - June)</p>
<h3>DOCUMENTS REQUIRED UPON APPLICATION</h3>	<p>Once student receives a confirmation of the acceptance of nomination, he or she will be required to provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CV in English, • a transcript of records (subjects completed at the Home University) • passport/ID scan (page with personal data), • certificate of English proficiency, • an official photo (passport format) • proof of insurance (to be covered by the student) <p>Documents must be submitted by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • June 30 – students nominated for the Winter semester or the whole year; • November 30 – students nominated for the Summer semester <p><u>The link to the registration will be sent to nominated students by email.</u></p>
<h3>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS</h3>	<p>The minimum level of B2 (according to the Council of Europe scale)</p>
<h3>ACCOMMODATION</h3>	<p>Nominated student can apply for a place at the AGH University Student Campus (procedures explained in an acceptance e-mail).</p> <p>A detailed pricelist is available at the AGH University Student Campus website (prices may be changed).</p> <p>Dormitory Office: dds@ms.agh.edu.pl.</p>

**On 3 and 23 June 2026, classes shall be held according to the Friday schedule. On 22 June 2026, classes shall be held according to the Thursday schedule.

***Foreign language exams organised by the Department of Foreign Languages are held on the first day of the examination session.
