Trainings

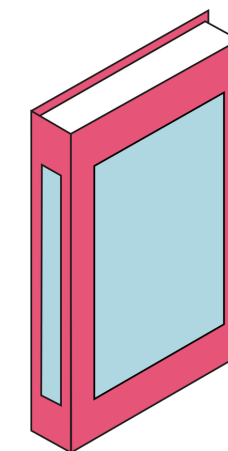
Before and during the Programme, you will participate in obligatory trainings and workshops conducted by Trainers Certified by the European Mentoring and Coaching Council

Group and individual supervisions

Each Mentor can take part in three group supervisions and one individual supervision, during which they will receive individual support in the process.



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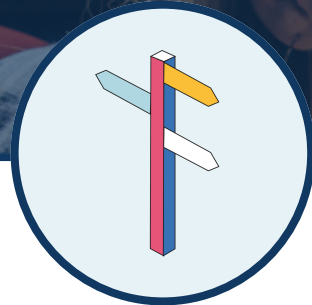
